








#### An Overview


- India is a vast country.
- It is the most populous country in the world.
- It is the seventh-largest country in the world by area.
- It is known for its diverse culture, rich history, and beautiful landscapes.

#### Location of India




- India is located in South Asia.
- It is surrounded by the Indian
   Ocean to the south, the Arabian
   Sea to the west, and the Bay of
   Bengal to the east.
- It has a coastline of about 7,500 kilometers
- It is located entirely in the Northern Hemisphere.
- The Tropic of Cancer divides India into two parts.

#### Size of India



- The total area of India is about 3.3 million square Kilometers.
- Its latitude ranges from 8° 4' N to 37° 6' N and its longitude ranges from 68° 7' E to 97° 25' E.
- It is the seventh-largest country in the world by land area.
- Its Standard Time is 5 hours and 30 minutes ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC+5:30).
- The difference in the time between Arunachal Pradesh & Gujarat is two hours.

# India's Neighbours



- India's neighbors are:
- Pakistan & Afghanistan to the northwest
- China, Nepal, and Bhutan to the north
- Bangladesh and Myanmar to the east
- Sri Lanka & Maldives to the South.

## Political and Administrative Divisions



India is divided into 28 states and 8 Union territories. The states have their own elected governments, while the Union territories are governed by the central government. The states and Union territories are further divided into districts.

## Physical Division



India can be divided into six physical regions:

- 1. The Himalayan Mountains
- 2. The Northern Plains
- 3. The Peninsular Plateau
- 4. The Coastal Plains
- 5. The Thar Desert
- 6. The Islands



# The Himalayan Mountain



They are located in South Asia.

They are the highest mountain range with the highest peak being Mount Everest.



### The Northern Plains



- 1. They are vast alluvial regions.
- 2. They are the most densely populated region in India.
- 3. They are known for their fertile soil and abundant water resources.



#### The Peninsular Plateau



- It is a large, elevated region in the southern part of the country.
- It is bordered by the Eastern and Western Ghats mountain ranges
- It is rich in mineral resources.
- It is also home to several important rivers such as the Godavari, Krishna, and Kaveri Rivers,

## The Coastal Plains



- They are a narrow strip of land.
- The eastern coastal plains are wider and more extensive, stretching from West Bengal to Tamil Nadu.
- The western coastal plains are narrower and run from Gujarat to Kerala.

### The Thar Desert



- It is a vast arid region that covers parts of western India.
- It is sandy terrain, extreme temperatures, and sparse vegetation.
- It is the largest desert in India.



## The Islands



The Andaman and Nicobar Islands are a group of islands located in the Bay of Bengal.

The Lakshadweep Islands are a chain of coral islands in the Arabian Sea
